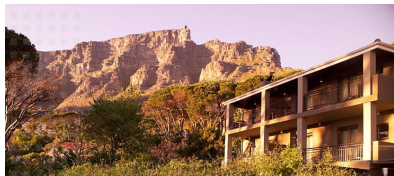

Day 1 – Kensington Place, Cape Town

On arrival in Cape Town, your Hills of Africa Travel representative will meet you and transfer you to your hotel.

Just outside Cape Town proper, in Higgovale, a quiet enclave overlooking the city from the foothills of Table Mountain, Kensington Place is about as intimate as they come — just eight suites, in a magazine-ready contemporary-luxe style, with all the bells and whistles, including sprawling king beds and decadent bathrooms complete with custom-made tubs and heated marble floors.

It's an owner-operated hotel, which only adds to the intimacy of the place. From within your room, it's possible to feel like a guest in a private home — all have balconies, some views of Cape Town, some more modern in style than others, but all are equally lounge-worthy, the kind of place you don't at all mind spending a few lazy hours some weekend morning.

|   | <p>DAY 5 – Tintswalo Safari Lodge, Kruger National Park This morning, your Hills of Africa Travel guide will transfer you to the Cape Town airport for your flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival in Johannesburg, you will need to check in for your flight to Hoedspruit. On arrival at Hoedspruit you will be met by a guide from Tintswalo and transferred to camp.</p> <p>Tintswalo is an exclusive safari lodge, located along a seasonal river bed in the private Manyeleti Reserve, within the Greater Kruger National Park.</p> <p>Tintswalo Main Lodge overlooks a waterhole frequented by elephant and other big game. The well appointed, air conditioned Tintswalo Explorer Suites are linked to the main lodge by raised walkways. Luxuries at the Explorer Suites include private outdoor showers, decks and plunge pools. The Baines Presidential Suite has two full suites joined by a spacious living area and open plan kitchen. One of the attractions of the Manyeleti Game Reserve is that there is minimal vehicle traffic. All of the Big Five may be spotted on your daily game drives and walking safaris in the Manyeleti. |  | <p>DAY 8 – Vuyatela, Kruger National Park This morning, following your early morning game drive and a large breakfast, you will fly by charter to Vuyatela in the Sabi Sands to continue your amazing safari.</p> <p>Like many of the lodges in Sabi Sand, Djuma actually comprises three separate camps, including Galago, a self-catering single unit lodge, and Bush Lodge, but it is Vuyatela, the flagship, which is really worth considering. Vuyatela is the youngest of the properties and the more exciting option design-wise. Unlike the rather bland and rather tasteful Afro-chic found elsewhere, Vuyatela is a celebration and fusion of southern African culture, and the lodge is fashioned from architectural</p> |



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materials similar to those used in villages and townships -- adobe mudpack walls are offset by corrugated iron, for instance -- and the crafts and artworks reflect African-style pop art, of which the Coca-Cola-bottle chandelier is a particularly fine example. Accommodations comprise eight thatched chalets, each with a generous bedroom, dressing room and bathroom, separate lounge, and large private deck with small plunge pool and shower. The cuisine reflects the lodge's Pan-African theme. Djuma is very much owner-managed, which means that service is excellent, and the game-viewing is pure Sabi Sand. Djuma has access to more than 9,000 hectares, of which it owns 7,000, making it one of the largest landowners in the Sabi Sand Reserve.. Djuma is proudly Fairtrade accredited.

DAY 10 – Tintswalo at Waterfall, Johannesburg

Today you will be transferred to Hoedspruit airport for your flight to Johannesburg. On arrival you will be met by a representative from **Tintswalo at Waterfall** and transferred to your hotel.
