### DAY 1 – The Safari Club, Johannesburg

On arrival in Johannesburg, your Hills of Africa Travel representative will meet you and transfer you to your hotel.

The Safari Club offers 17 luxury en-suite twin bedded rooms designed for both the foreign and local traveler in Southern Africa. ### DAY 2 – Khoka Moya, Kruger National Park

Today you will be transferred to Johannesburg Airport by your HOA representative. You will check in for your flight to Hoedspruit. On arrival at Hoedspruit you will be met by a guide from **Khoka Moya** who will transfer you by road (about 40 minutes) to camp. Khoka Moya is located in the game rich Manyeleti Reserve, which is home to only a few camps, so you will be secluded and well looked after. **Khoka Moya** offers a fun, interesting and packed Kids Activity Club where the kids go on shorter game drives, make necklaces from pods they've collected, make "elephant dung" cookies in the kitchen, etc.



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**Khoka Moya Camp** is situated on the border of the Kruger National Park in prime 'Big 5' Country - the beautiful and unexploited 23 000 hectare Manyeleti Game Reserve.

On your first night at Khoka Moya Safari Lodge, you will awake to a crackling dawn fire before the first game viewing of the day and your chance to see the 'Big 5'. With your hands warmed from a hot morning drink, rangers will take you on an adventure into the bush on foot or in customised viewing vehicles. As the day heightens, you leave the bush and return to camp for mid-morning brunch. Spend the afternoon relaxing by the pool, before venturing into the African bush once more for an evening's game viewing. Upon your return to the lodge, you will be treated to a gourmet dinner, followed by stories around the campfire.

#### **DAY 6 – Constantia Stables, Cape Town**

Today, you will be transfer to by road to Kruger Mpumalanga Airport (about 40 minutes). From here you will take a flight to Cape Town (about 1.5 hours). On arrival at Cape Town, you will be met by your Hills of Africa Guide who will transfer you to your guesthouse in the Constantia Winelands.

Constantia Stables is located just fifteen minutes from the center of the beautiful city of Cape Town. The guest bedrooms and main area are in a converted stable block, and there are two cottages in the well established garden. The dining room and small lounge area are in the main building and you can choose to have breakfast served on the veranda overlooking the small swimming pool.



Constantia Stables is well placed for exploring the Cape area. Favorite activities include hiking in the mountains or vineyards and day trips to the Cape Point Nature Reserve are all. Within fifty minutes drive are the famous winelands around Stellenbosch and Franschoek.

Highlights include a cable car ride up to the top of Table Mountain (weather permitting), Castle of Good Hope (Cape Town's first fort), the Malay Quarter and Green Market Square, where you will see a bustling market in action.</p>
	<p><b>DAY 10 – Grootbos Nature Reserve</b>          Today, your rental car will be delivered to you at 9.00am. From here you will drive to <b>Grootbos Nature Reserve</b>, about a 2 hour drive from Cape Town.</p>
	<p>Located close to Hermanus, en-route to the Garden Route, is South Africa's best-kept secret. <b>The Grootbos Private Nature Reserve</b> is 1200 hectares of pure Western Cape wilderness. The fynbos clad hills overlooking Walker Bay boast magnificent views of Cape Hangklip, Cape Point and Cape Aghullas. At Grootbos Private Nature Reserve nature will enchant you at every turn, fynbos - the most botanically prolific yet tiniest of the world's floral kingdoms, mystical milkwood forests, ancient tropical rain forests, fascinating fauna and a marine life that enthral.</p> <p>Grootbos Private Nature Reserve is set among the ancient milkwood trees, the large, private cottages give the weary traveller a chance to unwind, surrounded by the splendours of nature and pampered by all the comforts of home. Each Grootbos Private Nature Reserve cottage has its own secluded balcony from which you can admire the sunsets over the ocean or start the day in tune with the forest birds. 	<p><b>DAY 11 – Grootbos Nature Reserve</b>          Today, you will be transferred to the White House where you will be treated to a magnificent day of whale watching (in season: July - November) or shark diving with Dyer Island Cruises. At the end of your excursion, you will be transferred back to Grootbos.</p>



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#### **DAY 12 – Hog Hollow, Plettenberg Bay**

Today, you will drive to Plettenberg Bay, about 3 hours, along the beautiful and scenic Garden Route. After checking in to **Hog Hollow**, we invite you to "be touched by an elephant". The tours leave on the half hour from 8.30am to 4.30pm. You will drive to Knysna Elephant Park where you will take a tour and have the opportunity to touch, feed and photograph the gentle giants. Elephants love eating, so don't forget your bucket of elephant feed. There are no barriers or fences to spoil the close encounter.

#### **DAY 13 – Hog Hollow, Plettenberg Bay**

Today, we have booked for you to enjoy an exhilarating ride through the trees with Stormsriver Adventures on the **Tsitsikamma Treetop Canopy Tour**. Imagine the Tsitsikamma Forest....30 meters above, as you gently glide on 10 slides to 10 platforms high up in Giant trees. The platforms provide an unbelievable view of this enchanting New World. Spend a few minutes relaxing while your Guides enthusiastically explain the ecology of the forest – pointing out different trees and magnificent giant ferns way below. You may even sight the Knysna Loerie and the elusive Narina Trogon. About 3 hours later you exit the forest, having undertaken the journey of a lifetime. After your tour, you will find so much to do in the Plettenberg Bay area, this is home to miles of unspoilt golden beaches, forests and colorful flowers. Popular activities here include boating, whale watching, hiking, art gallery visits and enjoying the beach.
